Preface

This book is your guide to installing the AccuRev for LDAP Integration. It is intended for AccuRev® and LDAP system administrators and users.

What is the AccuRev for LDAP Integration?

The AccuRev for LDAP Integration is the integration between AccuRev and the LDAP (Lightweight Directory Access Protocol) that allows organizations with LDAP directory services to authenticate AccuRev users through the LDAP server via an AccuRev authentication trigger.

Using This Book

This book assumes you are familiar with your operating system and its commands, as well as with AccuRev, AccuWork, and LDAP.

1. Introduction

This chapter describes the highlights of the current release.

Note: Prior to version 2014.1, the AccuRev for LDAP Integration was known as AccuBridge for LDAP.

Highlights of this Release

AccuRev for LDAP Integration 2014.1 includes the following enhancements:

- A new LDAP user validation tool has been added. Administrators can manually run a user validation tool for maintenance and troubleshooting.
- You can automatically add or remove users. The LDAP user validation tool can automatically add or remove users in AccuRev depending on the user's current status in both LDAP and AccuRev.
- You can search for users. The LDAP tool enables you to specify criteria to search for specific users.
- The server_auth_trig.pl script has been replaced with a server_auth_trig file. In previous releases, a server_auth_trig.pl script was used to authenticate AccuRev users in LDAP. In the current release, this Perl script has been replaced by the server_auth_trig file which performs both user authentication and provisioning.

2. Installation Notes

This chapter describes how to install and configure AccuRev for LDAP Integration. It provides information on prerequisites and installation.

Prerequisites

Before installing the AccuRev for LDAP Integration, ensure that you have satisfied the following prerequisites:

- A functional installation of AccuRev 5.6 or later (including one or more clients and one or more servers).
- An AccuRev user identity (referred to as ais-user). For optimal security, this identity should be used *only* by the AccuRev for LDAP Integration. The AccuRev administrator should verify that ACL permissions are set appropriately for this user.
- A functional installation of an LDAP server. You will need the TCP/IP port number of your LDAP server.
- Verified network access via the IP network protocol to the machines that AccuRev, the LDAP
 application, and the AccuRev for LDAP Integration will be installed on. Verify the network
 connection to and from each machine. (The operating system's ping command is useful for this
 task.)
- A list of all AccuRev users.
- A list of all AccuRev groups and their membership.
- Access to an experienced LDAP administrator.

Installing AccuRev for LDAP Integration

To install the AccuRev for LDAP Integration:

- 1. If it does not exist already, create a **triggers** subdirectory in the **site_slice** directory within the AccuRev installation area on your AccuRev server.
- 2. Go to the Micro Focus SupportLine page:

- 3. Locate and download the ZIP file for the AccuRev for LDAP Integration.
- 4. Unpack the ZIP file to your AccuRev storage/site slice/triggers directory on your AccuRev server.
- 5. Depending on your operating system, Rename the **server_auth_trig** trigger file as appropriate to your operating system:
 - On Windows, rename server_auth_trig.bat to server_auth_trig
 - On UNIX or Linux, rename server_auth_trig.sh to server_auth_trig
- 6. On UNIX or Linux platforms only, make the **server_auth_trig** file executable by running the following command:

```
chmod +x server_auth_trig
```

- 7. Ensure that the **JAVA_HOME** environment variable in the **server_auth_trig** file points to the correct JRE location.
- 8. Ensure that the **config.properties** file contains the following lines:

```
Accurevuser=<ais_user name>
Accurevpassword=<ais_user password>
```

where *ais_user name* is the AccuRev user identity described in step 2 of the <u>Prerequisites</u> on page 3 and *ais_user password* is the password for that user.

What to Do Next

After you have successfully installed the AccuRev for LDAP Integration, you must restart your AccuRev server machine.


35280 -- Cannot run the trigger manually to add and remove users

In previous releases, users could not run the trigger manually to validate, add, remove, or search for users. This has been addressed in the current release.

To run the trigger manually:

- 1. Run startup in site_slice\triggers.
 - On Windows, run startup.bat
 - On UNIX and Linux, run startup.sh


The AccuRev LDAP dialog box appears:



- 2. Enter the name or IP address of your LDAP server in the **Host** text box. Note that the box is pre-filled with "**Idap:**//" to indicate that this syntax is required. If you erase it, you will be unable to connect to your LDAP server.
- 3. Enter the TCP/IP port number of your LDAP server in the **Port** text box.

4. Click Login.

The AccuRev LDAP dialog box expands to include the **Search** and **Validate User** buttons:



What you do next depends on whether you want to validate, add, or remove users or search for them.

Validating, Adding, and Removing Users

To validate, add or remove users, click the **Validate User** button. The User Validation dialog box appears:



Enter the name of the user in the **UserName** text box and click **Validate**.

Whether AccuRev for LDAP Integration validates, adds, or removes a user depends on whether or not the user exists in AccuRev, LDAP, both, or neither as described in the following table:

Table 1: User validation

User exists in User exists in

User exists in AccuRev?	User exists in LDAP?	Result
Yes	Yes	No changes.
Yes	No	User is made inactive in AccuRev.


User exists in AccuRev?	User exists in LDAP?	Result
No	Yes	User is created in AccuRev.
No	No	No changes.
Yes, but user is inactive	Yes	User is made active in AccuRev.
Yes, but user is inactive	No	User remains inactive in AccuRev.

Searching for Users

To search for users in LDAP:

1. Click the **Search** button.

The Search view dialog box appears:



2. Fill in the **Search DN**, **Filter**, and **Attributes** fields according to LDAP search syntax and click **Search** to return a list of users that match the search criteria you have specified.
