ControlPoint

This section describes the requirements for ControlPoint 5.7.0.

Hardware

This section identifies the hardware that ControlPoint 5.7.0 requires.

ControlPoint database server

Component	Minimum requirement
Processors	 64-bit environment Server class processors with 16 cores, with speeds of 2.5 GHz or better (minimum).
Memory	 64-bit environment 32-GB RAM as a minimum, especially for the server hosting the ControlPoint databases.
Storage	 Scale requirements depend on many factors including data sizes, usage patterns, infrastructure, and so on. For a large-scale database server host: Use 64-128 GB memory, as 90% of this memory should be allocated to the SQL Server. Ensure that other services are not located on the same host.
Dedicated hard drives for databases	 For optimal performance, adhere to these guidelines: Use the fastest performance-quality drives with the best I/O bandwidths available. For improved read and write performance of the ControlPointMetaStore database, Micro Focus recommends the use of an enterprise-level solid-state drive (SSD). During ControlPoint installation:

	 Place ControlPoint database files on volumes local to the SQL Server installation (<i>Required by SQL Server</i>)
	 Allocate the ControlPointMetaStore and tempdb databases on their own dedicated hard drive due to high disk usage.
